Assessment and testing is a regular and important element of the school curriculum, for all children in all classes. The purpose of assessment is to monitor the progress of the child, to inform the child and the parent of how well he/she is doing and to plan the next stage of learning.

Children are assessed using Teacher Assessment alongside County and National Tests

- YEAR R (4 and 5 years) Baseline Assessment
- YEAR 2 (6 and 7 years) End of Key Stage 1 Tests in Literacy and Numeracy
- YEAR 3 (7 and 8 years) Non Statutory Tests in Literacy and Numeracy
- YEAR 4 (8 and 9 years) Non Statutory Tests in Literacy and Numeracy
